Pastoral Reflection

God has gone up with a shout!

One season moves into another. 'Christ is Risen' becomes 'God has gone up with a shout' and, just as we move on from the Paschal season into Ascension, so too Ascensiontide will move into Pentecost... The seasons come and go!

I am mindful of this as I myself move into a new season in our life. My last Sunday Liturgy will be June 22 and my last weekday service will be Liturgy for the Nativity of St. John the Baptist on Tuesday, June 24. This will be 22 years to the day that I served my first Liturgy at St. Mary's.

I thank God for 43 years of active pastoral service as an Orthodox priest in The Orthodox Church in America, and I thank Him especially for the past decades I've been at St. Mary's. I'm sure every parish and community of our church is special, but St. Mary's has had a unique role in Orthodoxy: in the Twin Cities, in Minneapolis, in Minnesota, in Alaska, in America (and actually, North America, since it was from here missionaries went into the Canadian prairies) and even worldwide. What an honor and blessing to serve here!

Bilbo Baggins said at his 111th birthday dinner and farewell: "I don't know half of you half as well as I should like, and I like less than half of you half as well as you deserve." Understood in the most optimistic sense, he regrets that he hasn't known people as well as he would have liked to know them. I recall my early 'meet and greet' in 2003 when I said that I would like to be your priest: baptize your children, marry them, baptize their children, bury your parents, and maybe even you... Essentially my desire was to share in your life. That was the intent. If the desire sometimes fell short of the reality - may God forgive us! In varying degrees, God has blessed me to walk a bit with many of you, with your families, in your joys and sorrows. This has been a great joy!

A priest is a priest, and very definitely my retirement doesn't involve setting aside the precious priesthood granted me. It only involves that the requirements of the specific and particular responsibilities of being assigned as Dean to St. Mary's are set aside. Indeed, as a matter of form, the Archbishop has attached me to the altar of the diocesan cathedral in Chicago. But our home is here in the shadow of the Minneapolis Cathedral. We expect to be around in between the travel adventures we'd like to make while still we can - and enjoying our grandchildren wherever they are - and we will see how this all plays out.

In 'Dry Salvages', T.S. Eliot quotes Krishna on the battlefield saying: "Not farewell, but fare forward, voyagers!" Isn't this a great line? I often think of it when I'm doing funerals. For believers, the bitterness of our farewells are tempered by our faith, hope, and love. May we fare forward, by God's grace and according to His mercy, to what He has prepared for us!

Parish Homes Improvement

We are pleased to share that 95% of the renovation/update projects for both parish homes are completed.

The parish will welcome Very Rev. Andrew Jarmus and Matushka Kristi to our parish as he begins his role as Dean, effective August 1. Alice Woog met with Fr. Andrew and Matushak Kristi while they visited the parish from May 15-17. During that visit, they were able to view the home, find out information about the neighborhood, and begin to think about their transition to St. Mary's Orthodox Cathedral. They shared with several people how lovely the home was and that they look forward to their move in late July.

The work on the parish homes was directed and completed by our general contractor, Jim Curry. Jim developed and carried out a plan for all aspects of the renovation and always sought input and ideas on various aspects of the project. All sub-contractors were professional and provided excellent products and services for us.

Items that are on the 'to-do' list include an upgrade to the patio in the 414-17th Avenue home, landscaping improvements for both home properties, replacement of the back door awnings in both homes, in addition to other minor improvements.

The Parish Home Improvement Team is pleased with the work that has been done on our properties. We were pleased that many parishioners took a few minutes to do a walk-through of the homes. Also, we are so grateful to all who have donated and are still donating to the home improvement fund. By the end of the summer, we will have a final cost of renovation for both homes. If you have yet to make a donation to this project, please consider doing so. Our properties must be maintained in order to provide a comfortable, safe and welcoming home for our parish priests.

With the guidance of the Parish Home Improvement Team, a schedule of improvements and upgrades will be maintained so regular communication and maintenance can occur to ensure the comfort and safety in each home.

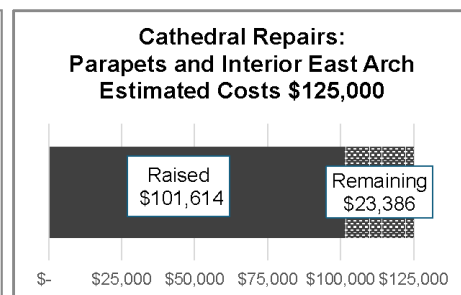
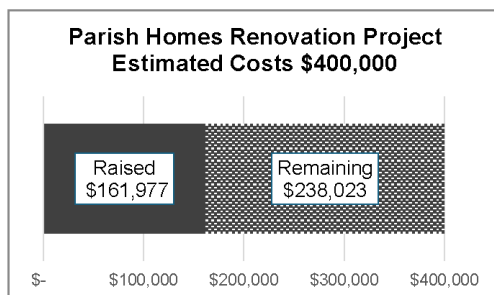
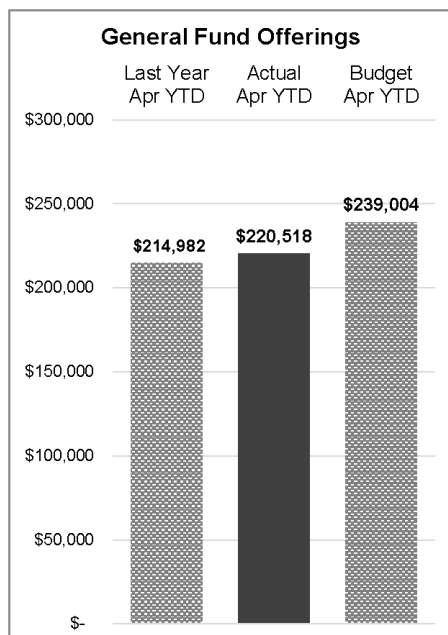
